Guruji Education Foundation (GEF) is a registered trust, which works with underprivileged students to enable their holistic education, and thus provide them with a more equitable access to opportunities and success. As part of its mission of "Education for All", GEF provides support for holistic education of underprivileged students, based on the principles of:

- Inclusivity
- Quality over quantity
- Cycle of giving
- Customized career planning
- Holistic development
- Collaboration

GEF runs 2 broad flagship programs:

- i) Holistic Higher Education (HHE), where high-potential college students from underprivileged sections are identified to catalyze their all-round development by providing them with resources that they may need. The resources could include interest-free loans (to be paid after they start earning), personal mentoring, career counselling and more
- ii) Adolescent Development Program (ADP), which aims at enabling schools, especially those catering to underprivileged children, to provide holistic education spanning physical literacy, psychological strength, intellectual prowess, life skills, and entrepreneurial thinking

GEF accords special attention towards education of students from a distressed backgrounds including orphans, single parent families, and families impacted by cancer, covid etc. More than academic brilliance, the emphasis is on providing these students an education that is appropriate to their abilities and can help them in getting meaningful employment.



GEF selected to join Scratch Education Collective

It is a matter of great pride that GEF is one among the only 52 organizations selected worldwide to be a part of the 2024-26 cohort of Scratch Education Collective (SEC). SEC is run by Scratch Foundation US, with the objective of getting institutions that are working on developing Scratch skills among underprivileged students, to collaborate with each other.

352 organizations from across the globe had applied for the cohort. The selection was based on an application and interview process. GEF was represented by Mr. Pranay Kalpavriksha, Mrs. Dnyanada Wagh, and Dr. Pradeep Waychal. Only 2 organizations from India got selected, with GEF being one of them.

Empowering Tribal Communities Through Education

The GEF team of Dr Pradeep Waychal, Managing Trustee, and Sanket Bhoyar, a successful GEF alumnus held a productive video conference with Mr. Ravindra Thakare, Additional Tribal Commissioner, Nagpur (IAS 2010 batch). Mr. Thakare oversees 133 Government Tribal Schools, 133 Government Aided Schools, 4 Military Schools, and Eklavya Model Residential Schools (EMRS) under his jurisdiction.

The discussion highlighted impressive initiatives such as Bhavishyavedhi, Brighter Mind, and Lift For Upliftment, which have led to remarkable achievements such as

- 37 students clearing JEE Mains, with 15 securing admissions in NITs
- 3 students qualifying for CLAT
- 6 students clearing NEET
- 173 students succeeding in CET

The GEF team commended Mr. Thakare for these milestones, and also introduced the various programs run by GEF across the country.

Mr. Thakare proposed introducing GEF programs in these schools and planning follow-up meetings to finalize the details. He also recommended connecting with the Gondavana Tribal Foundation. We look forward to working together to make a meaningful impact on the lives of tribal children and to support their overall development.



Visit to SSGMMS, Vadakkur



Preparing Students for the Corporate World

The session ended with an engaging discussion on handling the shift from college to corporate, confidence building, and converting Strengths & Weaknesses into Opportunities & Challenges.

 We are now running the 35th batch of the Spoken English program, and have covered 375 teachers and college & school students thus far



WAY FORWARD

Our Annual Plan for FY25 has a budget outlay of INR 1.35 Crores, with the following identified as key actions and priorities for the rest of the year:

Holistic Higher Education

- Add 50 new students to HHE
- Regularize meetings of all streams, start annual appraisals, and facilitate real-life projects

Adolescent Development Program

- Impact 10000 school students and reach out to 25 new schools
- Start programs in mixed (offline-online) mode with focus on developing brighter students as trainers

03 Entrepreneurship

Considering the overall job situation, we plan to focus on the Entrepreneurship dimension as part of the Adolescent Development Program

04 Geographical Spread

For more effective implementation and greater impact, we plan to adopt a "cluster" approach to scaling our operations by i) adding more schools in the vicinity of existing schools, and ii) adding new locations as hubs with a set of schools in and around the location

1 Improvement in Operations

- Explore right IT solutions for our needs
- Identify institutional donors with long-term commitment to support increasing scale of operations
- Add more mentors and hire administrative staff and coordinators / trainers

भरवसा - ठेवावा की नाही?

ही काळापूर्वी 'सोनू, तुझा माझ्यावर भरोसा नाय काय...' असे एक गाणे बन्यापैकी गाजले होते. आज त्याची आठवण होण्याचे कारण म्हणजे, नुकतेच वाचनात आतेले ब्रेगमन यांचे ह्यूमन काइंड - अ होपफुल हिस्ट्री हे पुस्तक.

त्यात त्यांनी मनुष्य प्राणी हा कसा जात्याच दयाळू. शांतिपूर्ण व सकारात्मक आहे, हे अतिशय पोटतिडकीने सांगितले आहे. त्यांनी समर्थनार्थ अनेक दाखले दिले आहेत. आणि जे काही प्रयोग वेगळे निष्कर्ष काढतात. जसे की स्टॅनफोर्ड प्रिझन आणि मिलमन प्रयोग, ते कसे चुकीचे आहेत, हे त्यातील त्रुटीसह दाखवून दिले आहे. त्यातील एक महत्त्वाचा भाग म्हणजे लॉर्ड ऑफ द फ्लाईज ही नोबेल पारितोषिक विजेत्या विल्यम्स गोल्डिंग यांची कादंबरी. त्या कथानकात एका निर्जन बेटावर अडकलेल्या ब्रिटिश मुलांची कल्पना केली आहे. त्यात शेवटी ही मुले हिंसक आणि क्रूर बनतात, असे दाखवले आहे. अर्थात ही काल्पनिक कादंबरी होती. ब्रेगमनने असा काही प्रसंग खरेच घडलेला आहे का, याची कसन तपासणी केल्यानंतर त्यांना असा एक प्रसंग आढळला. १९६५ मध्ये सहा टोंगन किशोरवयीन मुलांचा एक गट अटा या निर्जन बेटावर १५ महिने राहिला होता. आणि त्या परिस्थितीत स्वतःला सस्थितीत ठेवण्यात यशस्वी झाला होता. ती मुले दयाळू, शांतिपूर्ण, व सकारात्मक बनलेली आढळली. त्यांच्या मते नकारात्मकता वाढायला प्रसार माध्यमे कारणीभृत आहेत. तेही खरेच आहे.

ब्रेगमन यांनी काही मुद्दे ओढून ताणून मांडण्याचा किंवा पटवण्याचा प्रयत्न केला आहे, असे वाटते. त्यांच्या मते युद्धामध्ये सैनिक आपल्या देशापेक्षा सहकारी आणि मित्रांसाठी जास्त लढतात आणि कोणीही कुठल्याही व्यक्तीला अगदी परकीय सैनिकाला समोरासमोरच्या युद्धामध्ये मारीत नाही. बहुतेक मृत्यू हे बॉम्ब हल्त्यांमध्ये वगैरे होतात ज्याच्यामध्ये तुम्ही ज्यांना मारायचे त्या व्यक्तींना पाह शकत नाही, पाहत नाही. परंतु, पूर्वीच्या काळातील बहुतांशी युद्ध समोरासमोर होत असत व त्यात क्ररतेच्या सीमाही गाठल्या जात असत. लेखकाने अगदी ओंद्रन ताणून आपला मुद्दा मांडण्याचा प्रयत्न केला आहे, असे वाटते. अशी आणखीनही उदाहरणे आहेत त्यामुळे त्याच्यावर टीका पण झालेली आहे. त्यांच्या पुस्तकातील सर्व प्रसंगामध्ये पुरुष आहेत, महिला अजिबात नाहीत. म्हणजे हे पुस्तक ह्यूमन काइंड नसून मॅन काइंड आहे, असे वाटते. दयाळूपणाचा विचार जगाच्या पातळीवर केला तर भारतातील महात्मा गांधी आणि अनेक संत हे त्याचे अतिशय बोलके उदाहरण आहे, परंतु पुस्तकांमध्ये भारताच्या कुठल्याही व्यक्तीचा व प्रसंगाचा उल्लेख नाही.

तरीपण त्यातील मुख्य मुद्दा हा अतिशय महत्त्वाचा आहे - मनुष्य प्राणी हा जात्याच दयाळू, शांतिपूर्ण व सकारात्मक आहे. त्याच्यावरून विचार करताना पुढील अनेक गोष्टी लक्षात आल्या

त्या गाण्याचे सोडा परंतु व्यवहारांमध्ये आपण अनेकदा भरवसा नाही का, भरवसा ठेव... असे शब्दप्रयोग वापरतो. अर्थातच काही ठिकाणी भरवसा ठेवून लोकांची फसवणूक झालेली असते आणि त्यामुळे तो ठेवायचा की नाही याविषयी सामान्य मन साशंक असते

माणसे अशी का वागतात हा प्रश्न सगळ्यांनाच केव्हा ना केव्हा पडतो. त्याचे मानसशास्त्राने दिलेले उत्तर म्हणजे- वागणं हे त्याच्या जीन्स (जनुके) व त्याला लामलेले वातावरण यावर अवलंबून असते. हे वागणे कथी सकारात्मक तर कथी नकारात्मक असते. मानसशास्त्राचे जनक मानले जाणारे सिग्मंड फ्रॉईड यांनी व्यक्तिमत्त्वाच्या दोन बाजूंचा उल्लेख केला आहे. एक eros ही सकारात्मक बाजू आहे आणि एक thantos ही नकारात्मक बाजू आहे आणि या दोन्ही बाजू आपल्यामध्ये थोड्याफार प्रमाणात सतत कार्यरत

प्रसिद्ध मानसशास्त्रज्ञ एरिक्सन याने असं दाखवून दिलं आहे की, लहान मुलांमध्ये जन्मल्यापासून १८ महिन्यांचा होतपर्यंत त्याची काळजी नीट घेतली गेली असेल तर ते पुढील आयुष्यात भरवसा ठेवते.

प्रत्येकाचे वागणे परिस्थितीनुसार वेगवेगळे होत असले - म्हणजे भरवसा ठेवण्याजोगे अथवा न ठेवण्याजोगे तरीही एक्णात जास्त घटना अथवा परिस्थिती या भरवसा ठेवण्याच्या योग्य असतात व भरवसा ठेवल्या जाणान्या असतात. म्हणतात तसे सगळे जग दयाळू, शांतिपूर्ण व सकारात्मक नसेल तरीही जगाचा तराजू हा दयाळूपणा भरवसा किंवा सकारात्मककडे झुकलेला होता, आहे आणि असणार आहे, हे निश्चित.

त्याचा सगळ्यात सोपा पुरावा म्हणजे आतापर्यंत जग तगलेले आहे. जग जर निष्ठुर असते तर आतापर्यंत आपण एकमेकांचे गळे घोटून जगाचा अंत केला असता. जगामध्ये नेहमीच पांडव आणि कौरव म्हणजे सकारात्मक वृत्ती आणि नकारात्मक वृत्ती असणार, आहेत परंतु पांडव जगाला तारत आलेले आहेत आणि प्रापदेही तारतील.

अर्थात तुम्ही जेवडा भरवसा ठेवाल तेवडेच लोक तुमच्यावर जास्त भरवसा ठेवतील. तुमच्याच नटहे तर बाकीच्यांवर पण ठेवतील आणि सर्व जग सकारात्मककडे झुकायला लागेल. अर्थात आपल्याला परिस्थितीचा डोळसपणे विचार करून हे निर्णय घ्यायला पाहिजेत, परंतु आपण सर्वानी थोडा जास्त भरवसा ठेवला तर आपण एका आनंदालो धनी होऊ आणि नाही ठेवला तर एका आनंदाला मुकू, हे आपणास मान्य करायला लागेल. हे वाचून जर तुमच्यापैकी काही जणांनी थोडा जास्त भरवसा ठेवला तर हे लिहिण्याचं सार्थक होईल.
